HEALTH VISITOR	The Health Visitor is able to give advice on problems relating to a child under the age of 5 yrs such as sleeping, behavior, feeding and immunisations. She can also assist with any breast feeding issues.	
SMOKING CESSATION	<u>PHARMACISTS</u> can prescribe patches or Champix or you can self refer into the Smokefree Service on 0141 232 2110 for individual or group therapy support.	
HOSPITAL APPOINTMENTS	If you have any queries about your hospital appointments or waiting time, you can make enquiries yourself by calling Medical Records at Gartnavel General Hospital on <b>0141 347 8850</b> . They should be able to give you information or re-direct you to a more appropriate person.
